INTERVIEWEES

Examinees who belong to one or more of the groups listed below

1. Chest pain symptoms associated with exertion in the basic coronary interview (Questions 6 or 7 and 8 or 9B answered yes)
2. Chest pain symptoms possibly referring to an infarct in the basic coronary interview (Question 14 answered yes)
3. Regardless of the information from the basic coronary interview, if answers to questions A or B are yes

Has a doctor diagnosed you with (0=no, 1=yes)

A Coronary thrombosis

B Angina pectoris

A. ANGINA PECTORIS

1. **Have you felt any chest pain, discomfort or a sensation of weight in your chest when walking uphill or walking in fast pace on level ground**

0= no, go to section B

1= yes, 2=answer contradicting with basic interview

2. **At what age did you begin to feel these chest pain symptoms that occur during exertion?**

3. **Have the former symptoms appeared only after the previous Mobile Clinic health examination?**

(0=no, 1=yes)

4. **Have you been examined by a physician due to these exertional chest pain symptoms?**

(0=no, go to section B, 1=yes)

5. **What did the physician think was causing the exertional chest pain?**

(0= something other than coronary heart disease, 1= coronary heart disease)

[Doctor's estimate-diagnosis]

6. **At what age did you first visit a physician due to exertional chest pain?**

B. POSSIBLE INFARCT

7. **Have you ever felt severe pain lasting for over ½ hours in the centre of your chest?**

(0=no, 1=yes, 2=answer contradicting with basic coronary interview)

8. **Have you been treated at a hospital due to a coronary thrombosis or suspicion of it?**

(0=no, go to section C, 1=yes)

9. **In which hospital, which year and for how many weeks were you examined and treated because of a coronary thrombosis or suspicion of it during each hospital treatment period?**

WHERE WHEN DURATION

10. **At what age for the first time**

11. **Hospital treatment periods in total**

12. **Did the first hospital treatment period take place only after the previous Mobile Clinic health examination?**

(0=no, 1=yes)

C. TREATMENT

These questions only for interviewees, who have been diagnosed with angina pectoris or coronary thrombosis by a physician

13. **Current treatment prescribed due to angina pectoris or prior myocardial infarction**

(0=no treatment, 1=has treatment regimen, not followed, 2=has treatment regimen, followed)

a. Medical treatment: preparations

b. Dietary treatment: description

c. Rehabilitation programme

14. **Number of visits to a physician during the past 12 months**

15. **Upcoming physician appointment** (00=less than 1 months, 88=if needed, 99= not agreed)

16. **Continuity of the doctor-patient relationship** (0=no visits, 1=usually with different physician, 2= with the same physician)
