

AU77 Supplementary interview on urinary tract infection

INTERVIEWEES

PREREQUISITES:

1. Women only
2. Referred to a doctor or hospital from the previous Mobile Clinic health examination because of urinary tract infection (bacteriuria)
3. Controls for the subjects in the group 2 (groups 2 and 3 on computer list A and B)

Detection

- 1. Was one referred to a doctor or hospital from the previous Mobile Clinic health examination because of urinary tract infection (bacteriuria) (To be asked)**

- 2. Did you go to a doctor or hospital due to the MC referral (sent by mail) because of bacteria in your urine?**
