



### Percentages of men and women who smoke daily, by age 1997-2022






## Percentages of daily smokers among 14-to-20-year-old girls and boys in 2008/2009-2023






## Percentages of daily smokers among 14-to-20-year-old boys by level of education in 2000–2023






### Percentages of daily smokers among 14-to-20-year-old girls by level of education in 2000–2023






### Percentage of daily smokers of students in higher education in 2000–2021






## Percentage (%) of 14-20-year-olds boys and gilrs who use e-cigarettes daily by level of education in 2000–2023






### Percentage of smokers and quitters of smoking during the first trimester of a pregnancy by age group, preliminary data for 2022






# Cigarettes and cigars subject to tax (year = December-November) and cigarettes imported from abroad (year = January-December) for residents over 15 years of age in 1980–2022






## The nominal price indices of tobacco products and consumer price index in 1990–2022 (1990=100)

### **Main findings**

- Daily smoking among working-age people (20–64-year-olds) has decreased compared to 2020.
- Smoking among pensioners (65–84-year-olds) has remained at the same level as in 2020, although smoking among men has increased slightly.
- Smoking among 1st and 2nd year students at vocational institutions was lower in 2023 than in 2021. Even so, smoking was still more common among them than among 8th and 9th grade pupils and 1st and 2nd year students in general upper secondary school.
- The use of e-cigarettes has remained low among adults but has increased considerably among young people.
- Increasingly fewer women who have given birth reported having smoked after the first trimester and of those who had smoked, an increasing number reported that they had quit smoking during the first trimester.
